Our week commences with Palm Sunday festivities including waving palms fronds, singing children and adults and pageantry. All this will be on Sunday, March 16th at the 8:30 a.m., 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. services.

On Maundy Thursday (literally mandate Thursday, where Christ charged us to serve one another) we juxtapose to the reenactment of the Lord's Supper.
